COUNSELING AWARENESS LEGAL MOBILE (CALM) SERVICE



Centre for Awareness Promotion (CAP) Nepal started the camp since 2012 to work closely with women and girls working at Adult Entertainment and Hospitality Sectors (AEHS) like Dohori sajh, Dance bar, SPA, Massage centre, open restaurant and khaja ghar. This camp is one of the core activities of CAP Nepal to have interaction with the worker of this sector and to find their traumatic condition of past, inner feelings, personal/social/professional problems and needs. It also helps organization for outreach in the particular targeted entertainment sector, to know the current situation of AEHS, working environment, scenario of internal trafficking and risk factors of women and girls working in these sectors.

CAP Nepal conducted five days Counseling Awareness Legal Mobile (CALM) service in Hotel Shraddha Place Gaushala Kathmandu from 1st April to 5th April 2019. It was the first camp of 2019 which was conducted targeting women and girls working in entertainment and hospitality sectors. Before the start of the camp, CAP Nepal's field officer and volunteer conducted day and night field visit program at target area for dissemination of information regarding CALM service and organization.

CAP Nepal reached over 60 khaja ghar, 20 dohori sajha, 10 dance bar and 10 SPA and massage centre. CAP Nepal was able to deliver the information to 300 people targeting Chabhil, Boudha and Gaushala area. Total of 65 participants visited the camp and benefitted from service provided. Among the participants, total 55 participants were new and unique participants.

DELEGATION TO PROVINCE GOVERNMENT



The delegation of Freedom Fund (FF) network organization including CAP Nepal visited Ministry of Social Development, provincial government of province three to advocate for entertainment and hospitality business sectors free from human trafficking, child exploitation and forced labor. Minister urged to keep this sensitive issue in provincial policy after discussion.

SHELTER SUPPORT FOR MINORS



CAP Nepal registered four new cases for the shelter support in April 2019. Among them, one was seven years old girl from the Dhading district who is rape survivor. Three were from Rukum and Jajarkot district who were recognized as high risk of Commercial and Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC) and trafficking. CAP also reintegrated four residents to their family who were rescued from the dance bar of Thamel this April.
